## LUMP SUM METHOD OF PAYMENT

### SECTION 5– PAYMENTS TO ENGINEER

#### 5.1. Methods of Payment for Services and Expenses of ENGINEER.

5.1.1. *For Basic Services.* OWNER shall pay ENGINEER for Basic Services rendered under Section 1 (as amended and supplemented by Exhibit A “Further Description of Basic Engineering Services and Related Matters”) as follows:

5.1.1.1. *One Prime Contract.* If only one prime contract is awarded for construction, materials and equipment for the Project, a lump sum fee of \$ 68,000.00 for all Basic Services (except services of ENGINEER’s Resident Project Representative (and assistants) furnished under paragraph 1.6.2.1 and Operational Phase services furnished under paragraph 1.7): but, if the prime contract contains cost-plus or incentive savings provisions for Contractor’s basic compensation, a lump sum fee of \$ N/A for such services.

5.1.1.2. *Several Prime Contracts.* If more than one but less than N/A separate prime contracts are awarded for construction, materials and equipment for the Project, a lump sum fee of \$ N/A for all Basic Services (except services of ENGINEER’s Resident Project Representative (and assistants) furnished under paragraph 1.6.2.1 and Operational Phase services furnished under paragraph 1.7): but, if any prime contract contains cost-plus or incentive savings provisions for Contractor’s basic compensation, a lump sum fee of \$ N/A for such services.

5.1.1.3. *Resident Project Services.* For services of ENGINEER’s Resident Project Representative (and assistants) furnished under paragraph 1.6.2.1. on the basis of Salary Costs times a factor of 2.50 for services rendered by principals and employees assigned to resident Project representation. NOT APPLICABLE THIS CONTRACT

5.1.1.4. *Operational Phase Services.* For Operational Phase services furnished under paragraph 1.7, an amount equal to ENGINEER’s Salary Costs times a factor of 2.50 for services rendered by principals and employees engaged directly on the Project.

5.1.2. *For Additional Services.* OWNER shall pay ENGINEER for Additional Services rendered under

Section 2 as follows:

5.1.2.1. *General.* For Additional Services of ENGINEER’s principals and employees engaged directly on the Project and rendered pursuant to paragraph 2.1 or 2.2 (except services as a consultant or witness under paragraph 2.1.13), on the basis of ENGINEER’s Salary Costs times a factor of 2.50.

5.1.2.2. *Professional Associates and Consultants.* For services and Reimbursable Expenses of independent professional associates and consultants employed by ENGINEER to render Additional services pursuant to paragraph 2.1 or 2.2, the amount billed to ENGINEER therefor times a factor of 1.15.

5.1.2.3. *Serving as a Witness.* For services rendered by ENGINEER’s principals and employees as consultants or witnesses in any litigation, arbitration or other legal or administrative proceeding in accordance with paragraph 2.1.13. at the rate of \$ 350.00 per day or any portion thereof (but compensation for time spent in preparing to appear in any such litigation, arbitration or proceeding will be on the basis provided in paragraph 5.1.2.1). Compensation for ENGINEER’s independent professional associates and consultants will be on the basis provided in paragraph 5.1.2.2.

5.1.3. *For Reimbursable Expenses.* In addition to payments provided for in paragraphs 5.1.1 and 5.1.2. OWNER shall pay ENGINEER the actual costs of all Reimbursable Expenses incurred in connection with all Basic and Additional Services.

5.1.4. The terms “Salary Costs” and “Reimbursable Expenses” have the meanings assigned to them in paragraph 5.4.

#### 5.2. Times of Payments.

5.2.1. ENGINEER shall submit monthly statements for Basic and Additional Services rendered and for Reimbursable Expenses incurred. The statements will be based upon ENGINEER’s estimate of the proportion of the total services actually completed at the time of billing. OWNER shall make prompt monthly payments in response to ENGINEER’s monthly statements.

\*See Exhibit “C” for Proposed Fee Schedule

2.1.1. Preparation of applications and supporting documents (in addition to those furnished under Basic Services) for private or governmental grants, loans or advances in connection with the Project; preparation or review of environmental assessments and impact statements; review and evaluation of the effect on the design requirements of the Project of any such statements and documents prepared by others; and assistance in obtaining approvals of authorities having jurisdiction over the anticipated environmental impact of the Project.

2.1.2. Services to make measured drawings of or to investigate existing conditions or facilities, or to verify the accuracy of drawings or other information furnished by OWNER.

2.1.3. Services resulting from significant changes in the general scope, extent or character of the Project or its design including, but not limited to changes in size, complexity, OWNER's schedule, character of construction or method of financing; and revising previously accepted studies, reports, design documents or Contract Documents when such revisions are required by changes in laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, codes or orders enacted subsequent to the preparation of such studies, reports or documents, or are due to any other causes beyond ENGINEER's control.

2.1.4. Providing renderings or models for OWNER's use.

2.1.5. Preparing documents for alternate bids requested by OWNER for Contractor(s)' work which is not executed or documents for out-of-sequence work.

2.1.6. Investigations and studies involving, but not limited to, detailed consideration of operations, maintenance and overhead expenses; providing value engineering during the course of design; the preparation of Feasibility studies, cash flow and economic evaluations, rate schedules and appraisals; assistance in obtaining financing for the Project; evaluating processes available for licensing and assisting OWNER in obtaining process licensing; detailed quantity surveys of material, equipment and labor; and audits or inventories required in connection with construction performed by OWNER.

2.1.7. Furnishing services of independent professional associates and consultants for other than Basic Services (which include, but are not limited to customary civil, structural, mechanical and electrical engineering and customary architectural design incidental thereto); and providing data or services of the types described in paragraph 3.4 when OWNER employs ENGINEER to provide such data or services in lieu of furnishing same in

accordance with paragraph 3.4.

2.1.8. If ENGINEER's compensation is on the basis of a lump sum or percentage of Construction Cost or cost plus a fixed fee method of payment, services resulting from the award of more separate prime contracts for construction, materials or equipment for the Project than are contemplated by paragraph 5.1.1.2. If ENGINEER's compensation is on the basis percentage of Construction Cost and ENGINEER has been required to prepare Contract Documents on the assumption that more than one prime contract will be awarded for construction, materials and equipment, but only one prime contract is awarded for construction, materials and equipment for the Project, services attributable to the preparation of contract documentation that was rendered unusable and any revision additions to contract documentation used that was necessitated by the award of only one prime contract.

2.1.9. Services during out-of-town travel required of ENGINEER other than visits to the site or OWNER's office as required by Section 1.

2.1.10. Assistance in connection with bid protests, rebidding or renegotiating contracts for construction, materials, equipment or services, except when such assistance is required to complete services called for in paragraph 6.2.2.5.

2.1.11. Providing any type of property surveys or related engineering services needed for the transfer of interests in real property and field surveys for design purposes and engineering surveys and staking to enable Contractor(s) to proceed with their work; and providing other special field surveys.

2.1.12. Preparation of operating, maintenance and staffing manuals to supplement Basic Services under paragraph 1.7.3.

2.1.13. Preparing to serve or serving as consultant or witness for OWNER in any litigation, arbitration or other legal or administrative proceeding involving the Project (except for assistance in consultations which is included as part of Basic Services under paragraphs 1.2.3 and 1.4.2).

2.1.14. Additional services in connection with the Project, including services which are to be furnished by OWNER in accordance with Article 3, and services not otherwise provided for in this Agreement.



# Bayou Chene Floodgate Vicinity Map



### I. PURPOSE

At the request of the Assumption Parish Police Jury, this memorandum compares the Parish's Solar Energy Facility/Farm (SEFF) ordinance to Louisiana's state solar facility siting framework and identifies which regulation is more stringent by subject area. This review is intended to inform elected officials about where the Parish's regulations exceed state requirements, where state standards exceed local requirements, and where the requirements are generally comparable.

### II. DOCUMENTS REVIEWED

Assumption Parish Regulation (Local): Assumption Parish Solar Farm Facilities Ordinance, Ord. No. 24-03, adopted February 27, 2024.

Louisiana State Regulation (State): Louisiana solar siting permit framework and associated statutory requirements applicable to large solar facilities (including the state permitting threshold and siting standards for facilities commencing construction after January 1, 2026), as administered by the Louisiana Department of Energy and Natural Resources (LDENR) / Conservation & Energy.

### III. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY (FINDINGS)

**Overall Determination.** Assumption Parish's ordinance is more stringent than the State of Louisiana's baseline requirements in multiple major areas, particularly because it (1) applies at a smaller threshold (minimum 20 contiguous acres) than the state siting permit threshold ( $\geq 75$  acres), (2) requires extensive technical submittals (wildlife/endangered species report, glare analysis, "no net increase runoff" drainage plan, spill/hazard plan, and others), (3) establishes 100-foot setbacks from roads and property lines (exceeding the state road setback baseline of 50 feet), and (4) imposes a local permit fee equal to 2% of estimated construction cost.

However, Louisiana state law is more stringent in certain areas for state-regulated facilities beginning construction after January 1, 2026, including a noise standard tied to pre-construction ambient noise, a 100-foot setback from waterways, and more prescriptive vegetative barrier requirements tied to the residential setback framework.

### IV. CONCLUSION

Based on the review conducted, Assumption Parish's Solar Farm Facilities Ordinance (Ord. No. 24-03) is more stringent than Louisiana's state baseline requirements overall, primarily due to its broader applicability (smaller facility threshold), additional technical study requirements, more restrictive road/property line setbacks, emergency preparedness requirements, and significant cost-based permitting fee.

Louisiana state regulations are more stringent in certain discrete areas, particularly noise limitations tied to ambient conditions, waterways setbacks, and prescriptive vegetative barrier requirements applicable to state-permitted facilities beginning construction after January 1, 2026. Exhibit A provides the detailed side-by-side comparison and stringency determinations.

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 25-09 to authorize the levy of charges for removal of a Derelict Structure as an assessment to be added to the annual Ad Valorem tax bill of the property involved and/or authorizing the placement of a lien on the property involved for removal of Derelict Structure charges in accordance with Assumption Parish Ordinance No. 89-12 as amended.

Be It Ordained by the Assumption Parish Police Jury convened in Regular Session on this 14<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2026, that:

Section 1. The following properties, identified by assessment numbers, located within the Parish of Assumption, be levied with the stated charges due plus fifteen (15%) percent for administrative fees and fifteen (15%) percent for collections fees for removal of derelict structure, and said charges shall become an assessment and form part of the ad valorem taxes due on said property by the owner and when collected shall be credited to the general fund of the parish.

A certified copy of said special assessment shall be filed with the Clerk of Court of Assumption Parish, who shall forthwith record same in the Mortgage Records of said Parish. Such assessment when so filed and recorded shall operate as a lien and privilege against the property herein assessed, which lien and privilege shall rank from the date of filing of the assessment in the Mortgage Records of said Parish and shall prime all other claims, mortgages and liens, except taxes and prior recorded special assessment liens.

Section 3. If a section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect any other section, clause, paragraph, provision or portion of this Ordinance, the Police Jury of the Parish of Assumption hereby expressly declaring that it would have passed the remaining portions of this ordinance with the invalid portions omitted.

Section 4. Other ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
