

The Assumption Parish Police Jury is seeking a person to fill a vacancy on the South Central Louisiana Human Services Authority (SCLHSA). The Louisiana Legislature created the SCLHSA in 2006 to provide behavioral health and developmental disability services to individuals in Assumption, Lafourche, St. Charles, St. James, St. John, St. Mary and Terrebonne Parishes. These Board Members are responsible for ensuring that the services we provide and funding we receive is utilized to appropriately meet the needs of the individuals in our communities.

Interested persons are required to fit one or more of the following criteria:

- Professional expertise in the field of mental health.
- Professional expertise in the field of addictive disorders.
- Professional expertise in the field of developmental disabilities.
- Professional expertise in finance, accounting, or auditing.
- Representative of the judiciary, with particular emphasis on specialty courts.
- Representative of school-based healthcare, public health, or the coroner's office.
- A parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of addictive disorders.
- A parent, consumer, or advocate in the field of developmental disabilities.

This is a volunteer position. Mileage to and from meetings is reimbursed by the SCLHSA Board. The SCLHSA Board meets the 2nd Thursday of each month at 6:00PM at the SCLHSA Administration Office located at 158 Regal Row in Houma, Louisiana.
