


Proposed Complete Streets Improvements

Description of Proposed Facility Types and Provision of Transportation for Non-Drivers

The proposed sidewalks, crosswalks, signals, paved shoulders, and off-street pathways provide a means for non-drivers to access community destinations, including a church, park, and commercial destinations. The proposed visibility improvements would help drivers see oncoming traffic, both vehicular and non-motorized, increasing safety for both drivers and non-drivers.

List of State and Local Routes with Proposed Infrastructure Improvements

- Sidewalks along LA 400, Back Marais Rd
- Off street Path connecting LA 400 to Alvin Rd
- Crosswalks at Back Marais Rd and LA 400
- Crosswalks Back Marais Rd at Park
- Pedestrian activated signal and high visibility crosswalk at the church and parking lot
- Enhanced Paved Shoulders along LA 1
- Pedestrian Improvements to water crossing along LA 400

Community Input

In January of 2023 middle school students participated in a mapping study to identify routes that they utilized to get to the local park. This activity identify issues barriers and opportunities to improve the Complete Streets infrastructure in the community Supreme in Assumption Parish. Areas identified were a need for public and green spaces for physical activity, enhancements to the built environment to encourage active transportation and safer places to walk and bike.
